

## HAZARDOUS WASTE STORAGE AREA – WEEKLY INSPECTION

Central Accumulation Area – 180 day storage - Small Quantity Generator storage area

40 CFR 262.34(d)(4), 265.174, 264.1086, 265.15, 265.1087

**MUST** be inspected weekly (every 7 days) by trained personnel

<b>Containers in good condition</b> – All containers are free of rust, dents, bulging, cracks, leaks, punctures, etc.					
<b>Containers closed</b> – All containers are closed with screw on lid that is vapor tight and leak proof					
<b>Containers properly labeled</b> – Containers labeled: 1. Hazardous Waste 2. Waste hazard identified 3. Chemical constituents and volume percentages indicated					
<b>Containers marked with an Accumulation Start Date</b> – Date the container was placed into this storage area should be clearly marked. <i>*Must not exceed 180 days</i>					
<b>Incompatibles segregated</b> – All waste containers are segregated by hazard class					
<b>Proper aisle space maintained</b> – Minimum of 24 inches					
<b>No evidence of container spills or leaks</b>					
<b>Emergency equipment present and in good condition</b> – Communication device, spill kit, fire extinguisher, eye wash, safety shower are present and in good working order					
Document and date compliance problems along with corrective actions taken. Any item receiving a “N” requires corrective action
