



HAZARDOUS WASTE SATELLITE ACCUMULATION AREA

- 1. SELECT** a proper container to hold the chemical waste. The container must be compatible with the waste and be in good condition. No rust, bulging, cracks, leaks, etc. are allowed on waste containers.
- 2. LABEL** all containers prominently with the words **“HAZARDOUS WASTE”** and accurately list all constituents with an approximate percentage of each. Sum of all constituents must equal 100%.
- 3. CLOSE** all containers while in storage, except to add or remove waste. The cap should **prevent leakage** if container is tipped over in its side. Do not fill containers to greater than 90% capacity.
- 4. DESIGNATE** a satellite accumulation area **AT OR NEAR** the **POINT OF GENERATION**. Waste must be **UNDER THE CONTROL** and supervision of the generator.
- 5. LIMIT** hazardous waste volume to no more than **55 GALLONS. or 2.2 LBS** solid (1 QT liquid) of an **ACUTE HAZARDOUS WASTE** at any time. **KNOW** emergency exits and evacuation plans.
- 6. SEGREGATE** containers holding incompatible waste to avoid unsafe and uncontrolled reactions.
7. Do **NOT** mix **RADIOACTIVE** waste or **BIOHAZARDOUS** waste with hazardous waste. Collect and store all three types of waste in separate containers and locations.
- 8. TRAIN ANNUALLY** all personnel with the potential to handle or generate hazardous waste. Contact EHS&EM at **262-4008** to attend or to set up training for your department or lab.
- 9. PREPARE:** All SAAs must have ready access to **FIRE EXTINGUISHERS, HAZMAT SPILL KIT,** serviceable **COMMUNICATION DEVICE** and a minimum **AISLE SPACE** of **TWO FEET**.

Minor Chemical Spill:

1. Stop the spill
2. Cover the spill
3. Alert others
4. Decontaminate
5. Treat cleanup debris as hazardous waste

Major Chemical Spill:

1. Evacuate area and prevent further entry
2. Call University Police at **262-8000**
3. Call Emergency Coordinator at **262-7113**

Fire, Explosion, or Spill dangerous to life or health outside of facility:

1. Pull Fire Alarm
2. Evacuate, call **262-8000**
3. Call Emergency Coordinator at **262-7113**
